

## A Generous Helping Hand

**D**ear Friends: For over 60 years, Boyer Children's Clinic has offered comprehensive services to children with developmental delays and neuromuscular disorders. Our mission is to provide the best solutions for each child and family, regardless of ability to pay.

This past year was very successful and rewarding. During 2003, the Clinic provided services to 426 children and their families. Sixty percent of our families were low-income; a similar percentage came from minority or ethnically diverse backgrounds. Boyer provided 108 comprehensive medical evaluations, 463 round trips for families without any other means, and more therapy, special education, and family support services than in previous years.

We are pleased to report that the Board of Directors fully implemented an Endowment Fund in 2003. This is a crucial step toward ensuring that Boyer Children's Clinic has a consistent source of income to support future years of growth, so that we can continue to help each child and family in need of our services.

The new Endowment Fund is off to a great start. During 2003, the Fund received a lead gift of \$100,000 from the Norcliffe Foundation. In addition, the Clinic accepted an endowment contribution in the name of Nathan L. Jackman (July 11, 2000 – May 29, 2001) from his parents, Craig and Elizabeth Jackman. In creating this named endowment the Jackmans stated, "Nathan spent ten months receiving therapy and support through Boyer. Nathan had significant developmental delays due to birth trauma and through Boyer's services he began a road to reaching his maximum potential. Although Nathan's journey was cut short, we hope this endowment helps continue his journey in spirit."



The Jackman family and all who generously donated to the Endowment Fund in 2003 are indeed helping to ensure that Boyer's high-quality services will be available to children and families for years to come. Boyer Children's Clinic currently receives the majority of its operating funds from government contracts, the United Way, medical insurance and private contributions. These sources are critical for us to fulfill our mission, but they fluctuate depending on trends in giving and the often-turbulent financial health of the economy. They do not always keep pace with our financial needs.

As the demand for our services grows, our Endowment Fund will protect our future by providing a source of predictable income. It will improve budgeting and planning, substantially increase the value of smaller gifts over time, and provide continuity and stability of programs, even as the demand for our services grows.

Every aspect of Boyer Children's Clinic is augmented by the tremendous volunteer support we receive from our community. During 2003, hundreds of volunteers spent 8,409 hours helping us achieve our mission. Dedicated volunteers provided assistance in the classrooms; worked alongside therapists, family resource coordinators, and our medical staff; and helped create publicity materials and mailings. Our volunteer Board of Directors and special events committees added hundreds of additional hours, helping to raise funds to support Boyer's programs.

# Boyer “High Fives” in 2003

**THERAPY SERVICES** – Physical, occupational, and speech therapists provide age-appropriate support to children with delayed motor skills, low muscle tone, or delayed language skills to help them learn to explore and interact with their environment. Therapists assist families in learning techniques to use with their child when they care for them at home. Adaptive equipment such as orthotics and wheelchairs may be secured to help the child be as functional as possible. Children under 12 months of age may be seen at home or in their childcare setting. The number of children receiving therapy services at Boyer continued to grow in 2003, with therapists spending 6,661 hours helping them gain the skills necessary for them to live as independently as possible.

**SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSES** – Special education services are available either at Boyer or in a child’s home. The curriculum in the classrooms at Boyer is planned to include children with developmental delays as well as their typically developing peers. The daily schedule in the classrooms includes structured play around a selected theme for the week; sensory play or art activity; music time; snack (which includes time for special feeding concerns, if applicable); gross motor play; and free play or story time. Activities in the classrooms and in home programs are designed to meet the specific developmental needs of each child. Boyer provided 11,777 hours of classroom activity in 2003, aided by the 7,956 additional hours that volunteers spent working in our classrooms.

**SPECIAL GROUPS** – In addition to the early childhood special education classes, therapy services, and medical supervision that Boyer provides, our therapists also offer a feeding group and speech groups that provide additional

support to children with special needs. Our feeding group helps children who have limited oral motor skills strengthen the muscles and skills they use to eat, often allowing children to overcome their reliance on feeding tubes. Speech groups provide extra help to children with delayed language skills, assisting them in improving their ability to communicate with their caregivers and peers.

**VISION SERVICES** – For several years Boyer has offered specialized vision services to children with vision problems. One of our highly trained special educators is available to visit a family’s home and demonstrate techniques for a child’s caregivers to use in helping a child strengthen their vision. A vision group also meets regularly at Boyer, giving children a more controlled environment in which their vision skills can be stimulated and improved.

**AUTISM PROGRAM** – A rapidly increasing number of children diagnosed with autism seek services at Boyer. In 2003 the agency received a grant of \$10,000 which allowed eight staff members to attend a special training program on autism spectrum disorders at the University of Washington. After receiving that training, and with ongoing support from the Baby DATA autism training project at the University, Boyer was able to implement a new program designed to meet the specific needs of children with autism. Many techniques are used in this intensive program to enhance their communication, play, motor, and social skills. In addition, some children receive additional education and therapy services to meet their individual needs; each child’s program is based on their existing skills, and is created with detailed input from their family.

**FAMILY SERVICES** – Raising a child with developmental delays presents a unique set of challenges. Stresses are often compounded by parents’ lack of knowledge about their child’s condition and how to nurture their child’s special gifts. The Family Resource Coordinators (FRC’s) at Boyer work with families to help coordinate their child’s program, while giving them a greater ability to care for and advocate on behalf of their child. FRC’s provide one-on-one support to families and offer frequent classes and discussion groups to the caregivers of children receiving services at Boyer. In 2003 Boyer provided 3,927 hours of support to families at Boyer, helping to provide each family with the knowledge and confidence they need to successfully communicate with their child’s doctors, teachers, therapists, and other care providers throughout their lives.





**IECC CONFERENCE** – As a member of the Early Childhood Development Association of Washington (ECDAW), Boyer once again took on the administration of the Infant and Early Childhood Conference (IECC) in 2003. Now in its twenty-fourth year, this conference is the premiere training opportunity on children with special healthcare needs for early childhood providers across the State of Washington. The 2003 IECC was held in Yakima and successfully brought together several hundred parents, special educators, paraprofessionals, health care professionals, child care providers, and others interested in early childhood development for three days of workshops, speakers, and exhibits.

**UNITED WAY DESIGNATIONS** – United Way is an important source of funding for Boyer Children's Clinic, allowing us to offer our resources to children regardless of their families' ability to pay. Many United Way donors show their support for Boyer's programs by designating their contributions directly to Boyer. In 2003 these designations totaled over \$37,000, an impressive display of commitment from our constituents and our staff.

**PROFESSIONAL CONTINUING EDUCATION** – To assist therapists at Boyer and in the community to improve their clinical skills, Boyer hosted two continuing education courses. The first focused on treatment of the ribcage to improve respiration, speech and postural control in young children. The second explored the use of ball chairs in the classroom setting for improved attention and participation of children in school.

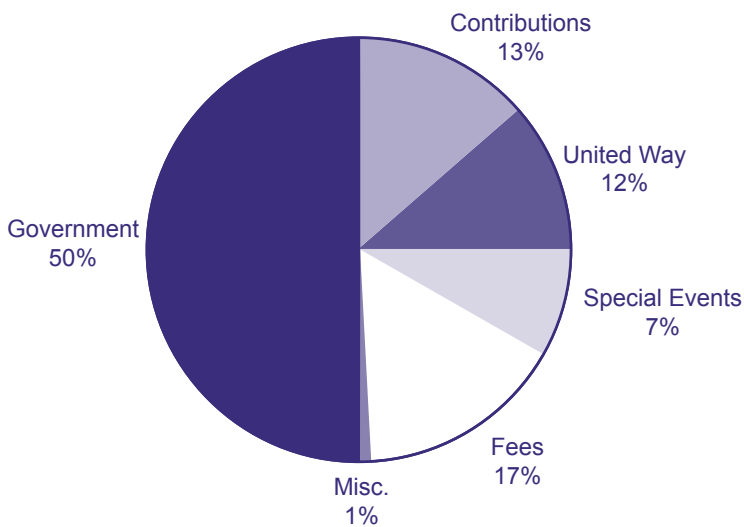

## Statement of Support, Revenue and Expenses for Operating Funds

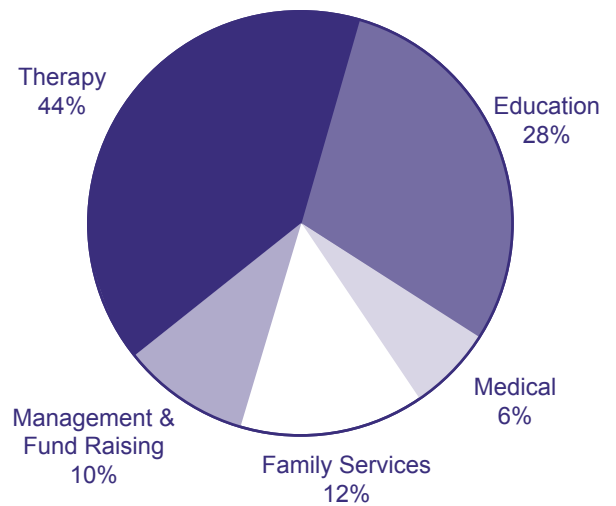
For the Year Ended December 31, 2003
