



Boyer's 3 - 5 Preschool Summer Camp



Join us this summer for a fun-filled camp for children ages three to five, led by a Master's-level certified teacher and two teaching assistants, that uses a variety of experiences for learning!



Children will participate in activities that embrace the outdoors, with themes that encourage exploration. Art, music, motor, and safety skills are incorporated into indoor and outdoor activities.

We'll become explorers together using our daily activities to understand the neighborhood habitat, and will compliment this with possible field trips. During snack, we'll read stories and encourage communication about the story and each other. We'll spend much of our day in our outside area where children can dig, climb, run, splash, slide, swing, study nature, catch bugs, grow flowers, create, and make believe.

We target all learning areas, with a special focus on social and emotional skills and essential approaches to learning, such as planning and problem solving. Our goal is to help each child experience joy in learning while building self-regulation and confidence.
