### Tiny Stars Community Co-op Toddler Playgroup (10-20 months)

Our groups are part of our inclusive community early childhood program where children of all abilities can learn and grow together. We offer a safe and caring environment for children ages 10 to 20 months. In this creative environment, instruction is individualized and tailored to each child's needs. Tiny Stars supports holistic development and building social skills together while having fun!

Tiny Stars Parent-Child Playgroup includes a weekly, one-hour session consisting of group activity experiences in a structured setting including music /story time, free play, snack time, gross motor movement time, and parent education topics. Each week, the toys and materials vary to facilitate curiosity and active exploration, and to reflect the unique child interests and needs of each group.

#### **At Boyer Children's Clinic, we believe:**

- Every child is capable of learning, making friends, and developing independence
- Parents and the community are essential partners in the lifelong learning process
- Children learn social, self-help, pre-academic, & communication skills through guided play
- Learning is the most meaningful when it is relevant and fun
- Our playgroups are a great stepping stone to preschool

#### **Our Staff:**

Each Tiny Stars playgroup is staffed by a lead teacher and a teaching assistant or volunteer. Special educators and physical, occupational and speech-language therapists may also join the group. All staff members hold a CPR and First Aid certification.

### Tuition

Families will receive a bill on the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month through our Raintree Electronic Records System. Tuition is accrued weekly, and families are billed for weeks that Boyer groups are in session.

Tuition supports classroom materials, operating expenses, and maintenance of adequate staffing.
